

Boulder Lake Rise Not So Rapid Now

The rate of rise of Boulder lake, recorded as in excess of three feet every twenty-four hours only a short time ago, has dropped off considerably, reports today reveal, with the water level today showing a gain of but eight tenths of a foot over yesterday.

The lake is now 84 miles in length, according to bureau of reclamation figures, and is still spreading out.

The Colorado river is now flowing at the rate of 26,700 second feet at Bright Angel checking station with 10,150 feet being released for consumption downstream.
