

# Congressional Party Due In City Tomorrow

The congressional party headed by Congressman J. G. Schrugham, coming west to visit Boulder dam, will arrive at the Las Vegas airport tomorrow afternoon in two Douglas land planes, probably at about one o'clock, according to word received at the local chamber of commerce headquarters.

The party, according to Secretary Oliver Goerman, consists of twelve members of the appropriations and naval affairs committees of the house of representatives, five naval officers, four pilots and two committee clerks, making a total of twenty-three.

The party will be met at the airport by the chamber of commerce and taken to the dam in the afternoon, returning to Las Vegas in the evening for dinner. Members on the chamber of commerce and others interested are cordially invited by Secretary Goerman to attend the dinner Friday night at eight o'clock, to be held at Lehman's cafe, and served in the Sal Sagev hotel patio. The committee in charge requests that reservations be made before nine o'clock in the morning at the chamber of commerce office.

A number in the party plan to spend the night at Charleston and the entire group will leave early Saturday morning for San Diego for a short visit to the fair.

A special publicity picture is to be taken at the dam and lake of this group, and Bob Denton, head of the Union Pacific news bureau, is making a special trip here to get the shot. The chamber of commerce entertainment committee, Harve Perry chairman, and transportation committee, James Cashman chairman, are in charge of arrangements.
