

BOULDER CITY PERMITEES MUST BE READY WITHIN NINETY DAYS

Ordered to Move Toward Establishing Stores In- side of Thirty Days

Boulder City permit holders who have not yet made a move toward actual establishing of their business in the Hoover Dam town must commence such definite action by 30 days from today.

For the local office of the bureau of reclamation today issued about a hundred notices to permittees that they have 30 days in which to commence "establishment of such facilities" and 90 days in which to complete these facilities,

or relinquish their permits.

Sixteen leases have been signed by permittees and the government men, and a number of the permit holders already are engaged in business, others being in various stages of construction.

Official headquarters of the reclamation bureau will remain in Las Vegas until about February 1, at which time the government offices will be moved into the new administration building, which will be completed about that time, it is stated in these notices

Conditions in Boulder City are now suitable for establishment of business facilities, the notice states. "Water and sewer mains are in service, streets have been graded, and although street pavements, curbs and sidewalks are not completed, building operations can proceed.

"In the construction of your building the work, however, must be so carried on as not to interfere with the activities of the New Mexico Construction company, contractor for street improvements since he latter has the right of way for such work.
