

# Engineers Study All-America Canal

WASHINGTON, July 2. (U.P.)—The consulting board of engineers of the federal reclamation bureau today sought to determine the best methods in construction of California's all-American canal.

They sought to choose a plan for an imperial dam across the Colorado river, diverting the waters into the project and for a route of the canal in the vicinity of Calexico.

In addition, the board is considering the amount of installed capacity of the power plants along the channel.

The board's major problem, according to R. F. Walter, of Denver, is "to design the defiltering works for the disposition of silt to be taken out of the waters of the river before diverting them into the canal."
