

All-American Canal Plans Are Drawn

WASHINGTON, July 24. (U.P.)—Plans for unification of the all-American canal in the vicinity of Calexico, California, have been drawn by the bureau of reclamation.

R. B. Williams, construction engineer, will go to Calexico about August 1 in an effort to meet objections of Calexicans who contend the canal will become an eyesore.

The plans call for landscaping of the canal, with grass, trees and boat landings in addition to a proposed swimming pool in the city.
