

# Medic Who Aided Dam Workers Dies

RIVERSIDE, Cal., July 25. (U.P.)  
—Funeral arrangements were being completed today for Dr. Cornelius Van Zwalenburg, scientist, who has been credited with saving hundreds of lives on Boulder dam.

Dr. Van Zwalenburg was the discoverer of the saline treatment for heat prostration and his discovery was the result of study of the workmen on the giant structure just out of Las Vegas, Nevada.

Dr. Van Zwalenburg died Tuesday evening of heart failure, the attack overcoming him while he was golfing. He was 77 years of age.
