

The Boulder dam stamp is apparently close to a reality, with all that remains being to set the date of issue. Bureau of reclamation engineers in Boulder City have been working on a special design for the stamp, and only recently retouched a late picture, to add the finished powerhouses, clear up the face of the dam, and provide an excellent reproduction of the project as it will look when completed. The design was made at the request of Postmaster-General Farley and will be sent to Washington shortly (if it isn't already on the way) to appear on the face of the memorial stamps. We should be hearing about the date of issue before very long.
