

# Boulder Lake Is Slowly Rising

Boulder Lake today shows a rise of one-tenth of a foot in elevation over yesterday, according to reports of the bureau of reclamation. The surface of the lake is now at elevation 928.4.

The flow of the Colorado river this morning is 900 cubic feet per second lower than yesterday, making the total 12,200 cubic feet per second. Water at the rate of 10,280 cubic feet per second is being released from the lake, allowing 1,920 cubic feet per second to remain in storage.
