

Picture of Dam Displayed At C of C

A picture of the Boulder dam, valued at \$700, painted by Morton R. Addy, well-known Chicago artist, was displayed before members of the chamber of commerce at their regular meeting today, and plans for the purchase of the picture are being considered by the organization.

The picture shows the project from the upstream side, portraying the surrounding mountains and details of the project, drawn approximately to scale.

Addy, who is residing at 320 Cass street, Las Vegas, did a series of paintings for the Alaskan government which appeared on display at the Chicago fair, as well as certain stage murals for Iowa state also shown in Chicago. Panoramic views of the Chicago fair which were painted by Addy, were used for publicity for the exposition, it was learned here today. He has done several desert studies during his stay in Las Vegas.
