

# TRAVEL DURING MONTH DOUBLES OVER THAT OF ONE YEAR AGO

32,456 Visitors Pass Thru  
Reservation Gates In  
31 Days

## TOTAL TO BE RAISED

Check of Travel Via Can-  
yon Ferry Not Included  
In Figures

With July of this year rating as one of the high months of 1935, instead of the second lowest as was the case in 1934, tourist travel to Boulder dam for the first seven months of this year was almost double that of 1934, figures released this morning by the bureau of reclamation revealed.

During the month just closed a total of 32,456 visitors saw the dam, as compared to 17,521 for July of 1934, establishing a record greater than any month last year with the exception of December, and outranking January, May and June of this year.

**THESE FIGURES** showed a total of 217,479 visitors to the dam since the first of the year, as compared to a total of 139,388 for the same period a year ago, and 265,428 for all of last year.

The 1934 total is expected to be reached by about September 10, with all that visit the dam after that date representing the increase over last year.

**THE FIGURES** for July of this year do not include the number coming in by the way of Black Canyon ferry, and Chief Ranger W. H. Trimble expects that this total will add several hundred to the 32,496, possibly enough to bring July to the second spot in the year to date.
