

DAM TOURIST FIGURES CLIMB

Figures on the number of tourists visiting Boulder Dam by the way of the Cashman ferry, boosted July into second place among the banner months of 1935 and brought the total number of visitors for the year to 219,728 up to August first, bureau of reclamation officials said this morning.

A total of 2,459 visitors in 804 automobiles entered Boulder City by the way of the ferry during the month, bringing the total visitors up to 34,915, shoving April into third place with its total of 33,475.

February still holds top spot for the year with 39,884, although it is expected that one of the fall months will break the 40,000 mark for the first time.

July of last year saw only 17,521 visitors, just 65 more than half the 1935 figure for the same month.
