

Life Guard Takes Lake Statistics

Statistics to be compiled daily by Alfred Straub, newly appointed life-guard of the Boulder lake beaches, will be added to official bureau of reclamation and Boulder police department records.

Straub reports today that yesterday a total of 134 persons swam in the new lake. Of the total 79 were adults and 55 were children. The number consists of those who swam yesterday afternoon and evening only.

Straub, who is directly responsible to Chief Ranger W. H. Trimble, is to see that the rules and regulations governing boating and swimming activities at the lake are carried out also, it was learned today.
