

August Takes Third Place in Boulder Dam Tourist Travel, Figures Reveal

August tourist travel will take third place among the months of 1935 so far recorded, figures released by the reclamation bureau at Boulder City indicated this morning.

The total number passing thru the reservation gate up to midnight Saturday night was 32,142, these figures revealed. They do not include the total entering by way of the Cashman ferry, which is expected to be around 1,500, bringing the total to approximately 33,600 for the month.

This figure would top all months

except February and July, a tally shows, and gives an average for the month of slightly in excess of 1,000 persons per day.

The highest figure for August was recorded on Saturday, the 24th, when 1,219 visitors passed thru the gates.

The Labor day holiday saw 5,099 checking in to visit the dam for the three day period.

On Saturday, the total was 1,399, Sunday, 2,330, and Monday, 1,370, the figures showed.

Totals for the month, including the ferry visitors, will be released within the next few days.
