

3 MORE POWER DISTRICTS FOR SOUTH NEVADA

Alamo, Searchlight and Moapa Valley File to Get Dam Power

Creation of three additional power districts in southern Nevada to enable these sections to benefit by the availability of cheap Boulder dam power is proposed in applications received by the public service commission, according to notices arriving here today.

Alamo, thriving Pahrana-gat Valley farming community, will present its case at a hearing to be held at the school-house on September 21, the commission announced today.

This district would be known as Alamo Power District No. 3, and would comprise the school district at that point. The plan is to tap the Pioche power line at the nearest point to secure electrical energy for the ranches of that vicinity.

The second hearing will be held September 23, when the mine owners and residents of Searchlight school district meet with the commission to stress the need for their district being added to the list in order that the dam power can be brought in to stimulate mining development.

On September 28, a similar hearing will be held in Overton for Moapa Valley users. This section plans to bring Boulder dam power in for domestic use and pumping, either thru a direct line or by tapping the Pioche line.
