

INSTRUCTIONS TO TOURISTS GOING TO FETE GIVEN

Walker Young Gives Out
Notice Concerning
Travel to Dam 10F2

Formal instructions for those visiting the Boulder dam project for the dedicatory exercises Monday were issued yesterday afternoon by Walker R. Young, construction engineer for the bureau of reclamation, who is in charge of arrangements.

The address is scheduled for 11 o'clock but will probably be sometime between that hour and 12 o'clock, Young pointed out.

The president will speak from the Nevada dam abutment in view of all those assembled on the huge structure. A public address system will provide amplification so that all on the dam and the Arizona highway approach may hear the president's words. The dedicatory ceremony is expected to be broadcast over nation-wide networks.

PARKING FACILITIES for automobiles are restricted as only a limited number can be parked within the immediate vicinity of the dam and these must be placed in massed formation. Other cars must be left along the highway toward Boulder City.

All roads to the damsite will be closed to the public from 8 a. m. until 10 a. m. during the time the president is inspecting the project.

FOR THE information of those traveling by car, the approach to the damsite is over highway No. 91 through Las Vegas and Boulder City, Nevada, or over highway 66 through Kingman, Arizona. The road across the dam has as yet not been opened to travel but for those using highway 66 on this

occasion the road across the dam will be thrown open at noon Sunday, September 29, and remain open until noon the following Tuesday. Cars, however, will not be permitted to cross the dam on the day of the dedication between the hours of 8 a. m. and 4 p. m. Those attending the ceremony from the Arizona side should therefore provide themselves with lunch and an ample supply of drinking water.

HOTEL accommodations in Boulder City and Las Vegas are inadequate for the large number of visitors expected. Rooms in private residences may be secured by application to the chamber of commerce in Las Vegas or the Boulder dam service bureau in Boulder City. The contractor's mess hall in Boulder City and various restaurants in the two towns will serve meals throughout the day of the dedication.

We wish particularly to impress upon all those attending the dedication, the necessity for implicit obedience to the instructions given by the officers in charge of traffic and request that everyone remain in his assigned place until after the president and his party have left the dam following the dedication.

TO GET TO the Boulder canyon project for the dedication ceremonies, each car must have a red seal signed by Chief Ranger W. H. Trimble. Only these cars will be allowed to get past the rigging loft parking area.
