

PARKER DAM TO RESUME AT ONCE

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 3. (U.P.)—
F. E. Weymouth, general manager
of the Metropolitan Water district,
officially announced today that
work on the Parker dam would
be resumed at once after a five-
month shut-down due to Arizona's
protest.

Arizona challenged the right of
the reclamation bureau to build the
dam without authorization by con-
gress and Secretary Harold Ickes
ordered resumption of operations
after congress passed the enabling
legislation.

J. F. Shea, subcontractor on the
project, advised Weymouth that he
is ready to proceed.
