

VEGAS OFFICE SUPPLIES LABOR FOR DAM WORK

10-5-35 Workmen to Be Chosen From Federal - State Employment Office

Walker R. Young, construction engineer for the bureau of reclamation of the Boulder canyon project, who stated several days ago that a crew of approximately 500 men would eventually be employed during the installation of machinery in the powerhouse structure of the Boulder canyon project, today stated that the men to be employed in this work would be hired thru the federal-state employment service, at Las Vegas.

Young stated "Effective as of this date, all skilled and un-skilled labor applications for employment with the bureau of reclamation on the Boulder power plant installation feature of the Boulder canyon project should file their applications with the federal-state employment service at Las Vegas, Nevada."

ALL APPLICATIONS as previously filed at the project office in Boulder City have been transferred to the employment office, Young said, and all applicants for work of this character, including those who have already filed their applications at the project office, should register at that employment office.

Young, in his statement said, "It is understood that those employed by the bureau of reclamation will not be required to re-register. Effective at once, all employments for this job will be accomplished thru the federal-state employment service."
