

Congressmen Will Make Lake Trip

RENO, Oct. 8. (U.P.)—The entire interior department sub-committee of the house appropriations committee, will spend several days on Boulder lake beginning October 18, Chairman Jed Johnson of Oklahoma stated today.

Johnson predicted that the plans recently announced in Las Vegas for creation of a recreational area to include Boulder lake, would go thru, and that provision therefore would be made at the next session of congress.

Members of the committee will camp out at various spots along the lake on their inspection trip, and expect to be gone about a week, Johnson explained.

The Oklahoma representative is the guest of Congressman Scrugham at his home in Reno for several days.
