

Dam Road Is Open To Thru Traffic

The highway across Boulder dam is open only for thru traffic and will not be available to local travel for a week or ten days, Ralph Lowry, construction engineer for the bureau of reclamation, announced today.

Lowry states there is still considerable work being done on the Nevada abutment of the dam, and that until this is cleaned up, Las Vegas and Boulder City residents will not be allowed on the highway for the purpose of travelling across and returning immediately.

"We want everyone to use this highway and see everything there is to be seen, but things are more or less of a mess right now and this must be cleared up before we can open the roadway for all traffic. Right now only those headed for Kingman and points beyond will be allowed to cross the dam from this side," Lowry said.
