

# Strong Boulder Delegation To Urge Approval Of TWA Permit

A strong delegation from Boulder City will be present in Washington D. C. Monday to testify in behalf of the application of Transcontinental & Western Air Incorporated for permission to move the junction of their San Francisco and Los Angeles transcontinental routes from Winslow to the dam site town, it was learned today.

With Mayor L. L. Arnett, City Attorney Harry Austin, and Deputy District Attorney A. S. Henderson en route to the national capital to present Las Vegas' side of the argument, Paul Webb, proprietor of the Boulder Dam hotel, and prominent business man of the dam site community, left by TWA plane this morning

for the east, and was expected to be followed tomorrow by J. C. Manix, president of the Boulder City chamber of commerce, and Lisle Keys, president of the Boulder City Rotary club.

It is expected these leaders will testify in behalf of the application of TWA when the hearing resumes Monday, and at the same session before the postoffice department, the Las Vegas delegation will present their plea that the junction of the two routes be made in their city.

The hearing was originally scheduled to be concluded on Tuesday of this week but was held open until Monday at the request of Las Vegas in order that representatives of this community might be heard.
