

Northern Arizona Gets Boulder Power

KINGMAN, Oct. 21. — (UP)—
The first Boulder dam power to flow into Arizona was supplied to Kingman, Oatman, Chloride and other surrounding mining communities for a short time today, and regular service is expected to be established in less than a week.

The transmission of power was supplied over the lines of the Citizens Utility company and signalled a celebration for which northern Arizona has been waiting for 30 years.

A transmission power line, 70½ miles long, will carry the energy from Boulder dam. A spur of 4½ miles extends to Chloride.

The voltage will be 69,000 to Kingman, but will be stepped down to 45,000 for distribution to the mining communities.

Heretofore northern Arizona has been forced to depend on whatever power they could get from auxiliary generators.
