United States Senator William G. McAdoo and Mrs. McAdoo made their first visit to Boulder City and the Boulder dam recreational area yesterday. They were so highly pleased with all they saw that the senator said it was their purpose to return as soon as possible for a longer visit to do some brass fishing and to make the trip by boat into the lower reaches of the Grand canyon, over which the senator has flown many times in his own plane.

The senator and his wife drove to Boulder City via Death Valley, and left for Los Angeles last evening. At the Boulder Dam hotel they were guests of Sims

Ely, city manager, at a noon luncheon, following which they were the guests of A. C. Wingo and Mrs. Wingo, on a boat trip.

Later they went through the dam, accompanied by Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Manix, and Ely.

Beginning November 15, Senator McAdoo will take over his new duties as president of the Dollar Steamship lines, with headquarters at San Francisco. Humorously giped by members of the party on the issue which defeated him in the democratic primaries in California last month for renomination to the senate—"thirty dollars every Thursday"—the senator smilingly made no comment.
