

# Buzz Holstrom and Amos Burg Okeh on Trip Down Colorado

GRAND CANYON, Ariz., Oct. 21.—(UP)—Buzz Holmstrom, of Coquille, Oregon, and Amos Burg, of Protland, making the longest Colorado river voyage ever attempted, from Green River, Wyoming, to Guaymas, Mexico, were reported camped safely above the Sockdolager rapids, 20 miles upstream from here.

A signal fire, observed last night on a sand bar at the bottom of the Grand Canyon, indicated that the travelers were all right and today an observing party which went down into the canyon confirmed this indication.

Rangers sighted the fire and smoke at the river's side 20 miles east of here, below Desert View station, and a party was immediately organized to go down Bright Angel trail by muleback to await the coming of the party at Phantom ranch.

They left Ouray, Utah, three weeks ago to attempt the 500-mile second leg of their trip down the Colorado in a small boat, en route to Guaymas, Sonora, Mexico, on the Gulf of California.

Holmstrom and Burg passed Lee's Ferry, Arizona, three days ago.
