GRAND CANYON, Ariz., July 16. (UP)—First word of the Nevills scientific expedition since it left Lee's Ferry this week on the trip thru the Grand Canyon, was brought out today by two men who accompanied it thru the boiling waters of Badger Creek Rapids.

Jack McFarland, news cameraman and Ed Kerley, Indian trader, climbed the canyon walls to bring out the films of the thrilling trip.

They said: "An eight foot wave hit the side of our small boat and only Nevills daring skill saved us from possible drowning or being crushed on the rocks."
