

Dam Guide May Get Movie Fame

Larry Clark, bureau of reclamation guide at Boulder dam, will have a chance at motion picture fame as the result of a chance acquaintance with Jack Gordean, representative for Feldman-Blum corporation, booking agents in Beverly Hills.

Clark, in his official position as guide at the dam, became acquainted with Gordean, on October 3. During the tour of the dam Gordean took several kodak pictures of Clark, stating that if the pictures turned out as good as he thought they would, he would

contact Clark in the near future.

A few days ago Clark received a letter from Gordean saying that the enlarged pictures were more than satisfactory, and asking Clark to come to Beverly Hills as soon as possible for screen test and training, with all expenses paid.
