

# Water "Curtain Will And Dormitory T

## Six Companies Will Put Up Sprinkler System In Congested Section

A "curtain" of water will segregate the Six Companies mess hall and Dormitory number two in case of fire.

In line with the company's policy to provide complete fire protection for their buildings, it is planned to install next week a water curtain between the ends of the two buildings, according to information released today by Norman S. Gallison, director of public relations for Six Companies.

This will provide a fire protection in the center of the area of greatest congestion of buildings. Dormitories number one and two, mess hall, dormitory number four, Boulder City company office building, Boulder City company warehouse and Six Companies laundry are located in this block, bounded by Cherry, Arizona and Date streets and Nevada Highway.

A six inch water line will be run in from the eight inch water main in Cherry street. A series of spray nozzles will be installed along the eaves of the south end of dormitory number two. These nozzles will discharge more than 600 gallons of water per minute, making a sheet of water protection from fire. The discharge will be equal to that of three fire hoses playing full stream upon a building.
