

BOULDER DAM CUT BATTLED

WASHINGTON, May 6 (AP).—The House appropriations committee today began an investigation into the effect of the decreased appropriation for the construction of Boulder dam.

Secretary Wilbur requested \$10,000,000 to carry on the work, but the House lopped off \$2,000,000 and the Senate reduced it another \$2,000,000.

W. A. Bechtel, president of the Six Companies Inc.; Henry J. Kaiser, chairman of the executive committee of the company, and Felix Kahn, treasurer, all of Boulder City, urged the committee to submit to the House a deficiency appropriation of several millions of dollars to carry on the work.

The committee took the request under consideration.
