

Curley the Barber Faces Rum Charge

"Curley the Barber," of Williamsville, is in the toils of the law. Uncle Sam's marshalls arrested him and a "partner" early yesterday on charge of liquor possession, and yesterday they were bound over to trial in federal court.

Frank Johnson and C. M. Cheever were stopped as they went thru the reservation gate about 1 a. m. yesterday, Deputy Marshall Bob Ziemer making the arrest when he found a gallon of whiskey in the rear of the new automobile in which the two men were traveling.

The men denied knowing anything about the liquor, but a search later of their home in Williamsville netted officers a small quantity of liquor and a number of empty bottles.

Bond was set at \$2,000 each for the men, W. J. Flowers, U. S. commissioner in Las Vegas, binding them over to trial.
