

3 Minor Accidents Reported at Dam

Three minor accidents were reported at the Boulder dam project over the week-end, all three men being treated at the Boulder City hospital.

Otis R. Munson, carpenter for Six Companies Inc., suffered a fractured heel when he jumped 15 feet off a form on the powerhouse. The accident occurred during the day shift on Saturday.

Harkey Elsberry, signalman for Six Companies Inc., was knocked off a form when a bucket, on number five cableway, hit the form and he fell some 20 feet, suffering severe head injuries. The accident occurred last night.

Mirlan Wern, carpenter for Six Companies Inc., this morning cut off his left index finger when the axe he was using, struck a piece of wood a glancing blow and slipped off, amputating the finger.
