

RESERVE COPS STAMP OUT

Gambling with playing cards on the reservation has been stopped by Chief of Police Bodell, he stated Monday night.

Notices have been posted in the recreation hall and at the river camp prohibiting gambling under penalty of violating reservation law.

The playing of cards has been permitted by police in the post, at the social halls as means of relaxation and amusement for the men off shift. It is now claimed that the privilege was abused and the law is being vigorously applied.

Instead of card playing for amusement, it has been reported gambling was substituted, in which intrinsic stakes were said to have been exchanged.

Such forms of gambling with no game percentage that usually is demanded by regular licensed clubs, began to draw undesirable professional gamblers onto the reservation, which were becoming a common nuisance, said Bodell.
