Replica at Fair

An estimated one million persons visited the replica of the Boulder Canyon project at the San Francisco exposition this year, according to reports of Jack and George Albright, owners of the model, who exhibited it under the auspices of the Las Vegas chamber of commerce at the federal building on Treasure Island last year and this.

The Albright brothers returned the model to Las Vegas this week-end and now are working on a plan to take it on a tour of the United States, if sponsorship of the plan can be obtained, they stated yesterday.

Ralph O. Dow of Las Vegas, who lectured and demonstrated the model at the fair, has returned to Las Vegas and will give his usual lecture before the Las Vegas chamber of commerce at the regular luncheon meeting next Tuesday.

Miss June Simon of Eldorado canyon, who was one of the assistants in the Nevada exhibit, was a guest at the chamber meeting and said that many visitors asked detailed questions regarding the southern part of the state and evinced an interest in the climate and the tax structure.

Federal Commissioner George Creel, who was in charge of the government building, in a letter to the chamber of commerce, commended the organization for sponsoring the showing of the replica at the fair and termed it one of the most popular exhibits in the federal building.
