

# Wage Adjustment At Dam Is Studied

The Central Labor Council of Clark county was notified today that the department of interior had ordered a formal hearing on the question of wage adjustments on the Boulder dam project, and had requested the department of labor to sit in on the hearings.

Harry W. Bashore, acting commissioner of reclamation, was the source of the order, according to Ragnald Fyhen, secretary of the council.

The agreement for the hearing came after some 400 bureau workmen on the dam project assembled after the day shift last Friday to back up their request for a hearing to E. A. Moritz, project engineer, who advised them his recommendation was already on the way to Washington.

The date has not been definitely set pending receipt of word from the labor department, Bashore advised Fyhen.
