

Ranger Recovers His Own Auto With Aid of Captain

Ranger Jim Miner parked his car about 11 o'clock Thursday night, across from the Boulder City police station, as he reported for duty on the graveyard shift, at the Arizona gate. Shortly after 2 a. m. as the convoy passed going toward Arizona, Miner recognized his own car, and Captain Bill Getts took the police car to pursue the machines.

About a mile east of the Arizona gate, the car was stopped and Captain Getts arrested H. J. Hubbell and Jim Lenzi. As they were ready to make the return trip Ranger Miner arrived at the scene of the arrest.

The keys had been left by Miner in the car and when Captain Getts made the arrest, a section of hose and a 10 gallon can of gasoline were found in the car, the officers said. The men are being held for violation of the Dyer act, for transporting a stolen car across a state line.
