

# EX-DENVER MAN IN HOOVER DAM GROUP

A former Denverite will have an important part in building the Hoover dam, plans for which have already been drawn by Denver engineers in the office of R. F. Walter, chief engineer of the United States reclamation bureau.

According to word received Tuesday A. H. Baer, well-known here for his work in connection with the Moffat tunnel, is now connected with the Morrison-Knudsen company of Boise, Idaho, one of the six companies which banded together to submit the low bid of approximately 4 million dollars for building the dam.

Mr. Baer was formerly treasurer of Hitchcock & Tinker, the contracting company on the Moffat tunnel project. He also was purchasing agent of the Moffat tunnel commission.

The Morrison-Knudsen company is also the concern with which Frank Crowe has been connected since 1925. Mr. Crowe has been selected by the six companies to be general superintendent of the Hoover dam work which will start virtually as soon as the contract is let, probably this week.
