

# Bridge Canyon Survey Complete

According to news dispatches from Washington, the survey for the Bridge Canyon dam on the Colorado river 20 miles northerly from Peach Springs in Mohave county has been completed and it is now ready to begin construction when the Reclamation department obtains funds to do the work. The fact that the Reclamation Service did not ask for an appropriation at this time does not mean there will be any delay in the construction as such appropriation can be asked for at any time.

A \$3,999,475 appropriation was made by congress for the continuation of the construction project of the Davis dam at Bullshead canyon in the Colorado river, 30 miles west of Kingman. Unconfirmed reports are that bids for this construction will be opened at the Denver office of the Reclamation Service at Denver sometime during the coming week. Bids were first reported to be opened in early February, but further data was required and engineers continued to gather the data.
