

Boulder Power Is At Full Service

Boulder City residents now have full and unlimited amounts of heating and electrical power, according to E. A. Moritz, superintendent of power.

The new substation and transmission line were completed during the night Monday, and power turned on for Boulder City about 5 o'clock. The street lights were turned on about half an hour later, and now ample power is available.

Likewise the Southern Nevada Power Company is free to serve its customers as amply as it has the need, Moritz said.

In announcing the completion of the repairs and the full availability of plenty of power for Boulder City, Moritz issued the following statement:

"The new substation and transmission line for Boulder City has been completed and placed in service. Ample power is now available for all purposes in Boulder City.

"I take this opportunity to express my appreciation to the bu-

reau of power and light of the city of Los Angeles, the Southern California Edison Co., Ltd., and the California Electric Power company for services and materials furnished; to the officials of the Southern Nevada Power company for making temporarily available all the power it could spare at considerable sacrifice to itself; to the engineers who designed and executed the plan; to the supervisors and workmen who worked long hours in inclement weather to complete the job; and to the people for their forbearance and cooperation in getting along with as little as 25% of their normal use of power.

“This was a demonstration of helpfulness, forbearance, cooperation and unity in action that speaks more than words can express, and all concerned are entitled to a deep feeling of gratification in the accomplishment.”
