

Dam Energy Sale Shows Increase

Boulder Dam electric energy sold by the state during the quarter ending February 28, 1942, was 18,300,363 kilowatt-hours, an increase of 6,109,079 kilowatt-hours or 50.12% over the 12,190,384 kilowatt-hours sold in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year, according to a report of the Colorado river commission.

Southern Nevada Power company used 11,222,363 kilowatt-hours during this quarter, an increase of 4,113,979 kilowatt-hours or 57.88% over the corresponding quarter in 1940-41. Lincoln county power district No. 5 used 6,637,707 kilowatt-hours during this quarter, an increase of 1,827,603 kilowatt-hours or 38% over the corresponding quarter in 1940-41. Overton power district No. 1 used 440,293 kilowatt-hours during this quarter, an increase of 168,397 kilowatt-hours or 61.93% over the corresponding quarter in 1940-41, the report shows.
