DIVISION APPROVED

Senate Committee Allots Mohave County \$50,000

Senate committee approval was given the bill drawn up by County Attorney Carl Hammond and special attorneys Charles P. Elmer and E. Elmo Bollinger regarding the division of monies received from the federal government for Boulder dam. The only change made in the bill as drawn up by the attorneys was that the senate committee lowered the annual amount asked for by the county to \$50,000 from \$150,000.

Elmer and Bollinger journeyed to Phoenix and appeared before the committee and were given invaluable aid by Senator J. Hubert Smith and Representative E. L. Jameson.

The senate committee has recommended the bill for passage to the senate.

Calif.-Arizona Boundary Comm. Meet In Needles

At the instance of Senator Paul Swing of California, a meeting was held in Needles last Friday of the Arizona and California Colorado river boundary committees.

Dr. W. J. Richards of Kingman was a member of the Arizona committee which was composed of Henry Wright, chairman, Charles Carson, vice-chairman, Alma Davis, secretary, and Mrs. Nellie Bush, member.

Forty delegates were present, including the members of the California committee, and executives of the Santa Fe Railroad, the Metropolitan Water District, and the recreational division of the Department of the Interior.

Principal discussion concerned the inundated areas of Havasu lake, involving Needles, Calif., and the re-establishment of sanitary conditions.
