

Observe Flag Day By Parade In B. C.

An impressive flag day parade was held in Boulder City last evening.

Chief C. F. Peterson led the lineup followed by the color bearers and Sons of American Legion drum and bugle corps. Next in line was the commander's car and the membership of the American Legion.

Soldiers from Camp Williston, 322 M. P. batallion, marched. The U. S. bureau of reclamation rangers followed, with groups of Vocation Bible school children and their leaders carrying flags in the rear.

The parade halted on the government lawn where the Rev.
