

Power Line to Dam Ahead of Schedule

RIVERSIDE, Cal., Mar. 14 (UP) — A power line which will carry the power necessary for start of work on Boulder dam will be ready for service June 1, or 24 days earlier than was anticipated, it was announced here Saturday.

The Southern Sierras Power company, building the line from San Bernardino to the dam site, agreed to have the power flowing by June 25, but is far ahead of the working schedule, the announcement said.

The entire line will be 230 miles long and will cost approximately \$1,500,000.
