

FIRST BOULDER CITY BIDS WILL BE OPENED IN VEGAS TOMORROW A. M.

Actual Construction of New Town To Be Under Way In Near Future.

Bids for the first unit of home construction in Boulder City will be opened in the local office of the reclamation bureau at 10 a. m. tomorrow.

The actual construction of the first twelve homes in the city which will house construction workers for the Boulder Canyon dam project looms in the near future, the contract for these homes to be let by the reclamation bureau soon after the bids are opened tomorrow.

With the announcement of Frank T. Crowe, construction superintendent for Six Companies, Inc., dam contractors, that the company will start immediately the task of furnishing living quarters at Boulder City for a large proportion of his firm's employees, it appears evident that there will be great activity at the desert site of the future construction community, both on the part of the government and on the part of the contractors.

The government has been receiving bids for six three-room and six four-room residences, with various alternative types of construction, including hollow tile, terra cotta tile and frame stucco.

It is planned further contracts will be let by the government later for more houses, for government employees, the contract for the government administration building to be let at a later date.

The contractors will furnish homes for their employees it is provided.

Work on the water tank and auxiliary tank, on the hilltop over the Boulder City site, is going on apace, under the direction of the Butterfield construction company, the grading of the hilltop being virtually completed for the big tank, and the auxiliary tanks at the bottom of the hill being virtually built.

The bids will be opened tomorrow in the reclamation bureau offices in the Beckley building.
