

Paid Fire Fighters Hired By Boulder City Company Now

House Equipment Near
Office Dormitory

Organization of a paid fire department with a full time chief has been completed by Six Companies Inc., and A. J. Kaminsky has been engaged to devote his full time to this and to sanitary inspection of the dormitories.

Kaminsky and ten other men are being housed in contiguous rooms in dormitory number three, and plans are under way for installation of a gong, and also telephones in the chief's room.

The Boulder City company has asked permission to house the apparatus in a structure between dormitory three and the office dormitory. Action has not been taken as yet on this request, but it is expected the permission will be granted by the city commissioners at their next meeting.

Each of the ten members of the fire department gets \$7.50 bonus monthly for his work, from the Boulder City company. The men are half night and half day men, the day shift being H. Lindsay, R. Thresher, F. C. Letterman, Lee Hammont, and M. W. Meade, and the night shift being J. B. Baker, Pete Russell, James R. Rowe, M. Farmer and H. Howard.
