Tied up for five months on the Hoover dam reservation, U. S. Deputy Marshall Claude Williams' big police dog, Rex, which had been long since given up by the officer as lost, was recovered recently and is now quartered at Williams' home in Boulder City.

The dog was found missing September 1, having disappeared from the temporary camp at McKeeverville.

Williams recently went down to the Sullivan mining claim, in the middle of the reservation, and there came upon a big dog, tied near a tent. He recognized his long-lost dog of five months absence, and inquired of the woman there.

She said she bought the dog early in September from a man who passed through.
