

Dam Burglar Now Toting Gun Bullet

Somewhere in Boulder City or Las Vegas, a would-be burglar is carrying a bullet from the gun of Chief of Police Bud Bodell of the government city, fired early this morning when the officer discovered the man attempting to force a window of the Browder cafe.

Bodell came upon the man while patrolling the streets of Boulder City in his car about 4 o'clock, immediately stopped his car and gave chase.

Examining the pavement, Bodell discovered blood spots, and believes he wounded the prowler with the second shot. All hospitals have been notified to watch for a man with a bullet wound, and Bodell is confident he will apprehend his prowler, although no word had been received up to noon today.
