

Pair In Dam Jail After Car Crash

Sam Panfillow and John Kofoed are in the Boulder City jail today, facing charges of drunken driving as a result of an auto wreck on the Boulder highway shortly after one o'clock this afternoon.

The men were arrested at the reservation gate by Ernie May, one of the rangers, upon information supplied by Sheriff Joe Keate. When May sought to arrest the pair, they threw their car into reverse and backed to the Searchlight road as rapidly as possible. May commandeered a passing auto and gave chase, finally forcing them off the road and making the capture.

According to officers, the men threw a quart bottle of whiskey out of the car when they finally arrived at the gate.

Details of the accident were unavailable, at press time, but it is known that the men, driving a Hudson, hit a Ford coupe and failed to stop. The Ford was driven by William Piccole.
