

FEDERAL OFFICES AT NEW BUILDING

Post Office Also Doing
Business in New Muni-
cipal Building Now.

Offices of the government men in charge of the destinies of Hoover dam and Boulder City today for the first time were doing business in every department from the new Administration and Municipal buildings in Boulder City.

Walker R. Young, construction engineer, and his entire staff, today held forth in the fine new structure at the top of the hill overlooking both Boulder City and the Hoover dam "lake" basin.

While the office of City Manager Sims Ely, the police station and the post office all were located in the permanent building recently completed by the government on Arizona street just east of South Escalante plaza, in the heart of the community.

Though some of the offices were completely moved about the middle of last week, the official opening of the headquarters in Boulder City was this morning.

Some of the members of the staff of the construction engineers are living in Boulder, while other must journey out from Las Vegas each day until their homes are completed.

Young's residence on Denver street near Nevada, will be ready for occupancy in a week or two, at which time the engineer will move his home from Las Vegas.

Homes of Office Engineer John C. Page, Field Engineer Ralph Lowry and Legal Counsel J. H. Alexander are also nearing completion.

City Engineer Matthews will work in both the Administration building and the Municipal building, for the present at least.
