

E. B. Bishop Dies Of His Injuries

E. B. Bishop, employed as truck driver by Six Companies Inc., who was critically injured recently, when his machine, loaded with 15 tons of muck, went off the grade and fell into the Colorado river, died late Wednesday afternoon at the Boulder City hospital, where he was taken immediately after he was rescued from beneath his truck.

The young man who had been employed on the dam only two days, was making the trip in company with an older employe of the company when the accident occurred. When the heavily loaded machine started sliding down the embankment, Bishop's companion jumped to safety. Bishop, in attempting to clear the truck, was caught underneath. When taken from the river, he was found to have suffered internal injuries, together with having both legs badly mangled.

At a late hour today none of his relatives had been located. His body was taken to the Palm Funeral Home, Las Vegas.
