

Tunnel Victim Body Will Be Sent South

The body of John Moore, 32, who was killed in an accident at tunnel 4 late Saturday night, will probably be taken to Picher, Oklahoma, it was announced today.

Moore was caught between the tunnel wall and a large concrete dump bucket. The bucket was used for pouring concrete for the bench supporting the invert jumbo. The bucket is suspended a crane and mounted on a truck, as the crane swung around, it pinned Moore against the tunnel wall crushing his body and fracturing his skull and jaw.

Moore died at 7:30 yesterday morning at the Boulder City hospital.

The deceased is survived by a widow and two children at Picher. The remains are at the Palm Funeral Home.
