

Addition To B. C.

Hospital Buildded

Because of the rapid growth of Boulder City an addition to the hospital became necessary, soon after the original unit was put to use.

That addition will soon be ready for use, at the cost of \$7,000.

The new structure is an extension of the south wing of the present building, and in conformity with the hill near the building the addition is two stories in height.

The lower story is one large ward of 20 beds while the second floor contains eight private rooms in addition to a 12 bed ward.

The addition is designed primarily for families of Boulder City although it will not be used for that entirely.

The main building of the hospital contains 20 beds, is equipped with an X-ray machine, a sterilizer, laboratory and an operating room.

Dr. Wales Haas is the physician in charge, with two assistants. First aid cases are cared for immediately, and with the additional room of the new wing a large number of patients can be accommodated, with the care of physicians and graduate nurses.
