

Reservation Census Outside Boulder City to Be Taken By April 1 By the Government; Contractor Plans Homes

Announcement that 18 new homes will be constructed in a block east of Utah Avenue, and word that the government will start a census on March 25 of families and persons living on the reservation outside Boulder City are the newest developments in Boulder City's housing situation.

While the deadline, April 1, nears the date on which residents of the reservation outside the city must move to permanent quarters, Six Companies Inc., rushes the construction of 250 new small cottages in the south part of town.

Now comes word that S. E. Hen-

derson, Portland, Oregon, contractor, will build 18 houses immediately, having virtually completed arrangements with the bureau of reclamation for leasing of an entire city block.

Henderson has ordered materials from California, and will build 18 homes first, to be followed by 40 or 50 more later if the demand is sufficient.

The government census will be taken between March 25 and April 1, to determine who is living outside Boulder City, and what steps they have taken toward getting quarters in Boulder City, it is stated.
